CERTIFICATE of the formation of a Partnership or Company for the promotion of Steam Navigation, in the Province of Wellington, under the Mixed Partnerships Act, Province of Wellington.

FIRST.—The style of the Partnership under which the Firm is to be conducted is **WILLIAM HICKSON, WILLIAM BARNARD RHODES, GEORGE HUNTER, WILLIAM BOWLER, WILLIAM WARING TAYLOR, and Others, Wellington Steam Navigation Company.**

SECOND.—The general nature of the business to be transacted by the partnership is the purchase of the steam vessel *Wanga Wanga*, and the conveyance of Passengers and Goods in Steam Vessels between such places as the Partnership or Company may, from time to time determine, within the Colony of New Zealand; and the doing all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
