PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON,
Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS, by the District Highways Act, 1856, of the Provincial Council of Wellington, Session III., No. 4, it was among other things enacted, that the Superintendent might for the purposes of that Act, from time to time, by Proclamation divide the Province, or any part thereof, into Districts: Now, therefore, I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby proclaim that the part of the Province comprised within the boundaries hereinafter described shall be a District, for the purposes of the said "District Highway's Act, 1856," viz.:—Along the North-Eastern boundary lines of Sections Sixty-five, Sixty-six, and Sixty-seven; thence along the South-Eastern and South-Western boundary lines of Section Sixty-seven; thence along the Eastern boundary lines of Sections Seventy, Seventy-two, and Seventy-four; thence along the Southern boundary lines of Sections Seventy-three and Seventy-four; thence along the South-Western boundary lines of Sections Seventy-three, Seventy-one, and Sixty-nine; thence along the North-Western boundary lines of Sections Sixty-nine and Sixty-eight; thence along the South-Western boundary line of Section Sixty-five to the Road; and thence along the North-Western boundary line of Section Sixty-five.
