PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, ESQUIRE, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, aforesaid, Do Hereby Proclaim and Notify that the Block of Land at Waikanae, known as the Mataibuka Block,—the boundaries of which are hereinafter mentioned, excepting certain reserves, will be open for purchase and selection under the regulations of the Fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, and additional Land Regulations, on and after the twenty-second day of August now next. The boundaries of the Mataibuka Block are as follows:—A line commencing on the Sea Coast, at the mouth of the Whareroa stream; thence along the Sea Coast in a Northerly direction to Wharemauku and on to Pukahu; thence striking inland in a South-Westerly direction, and crossing to Hakakohia-a-Toheahumu, it proceeds in a direct line

over the mountain ranges to Tararua, to the boundary of the land formerly ceded by Ngatikahungunu to the Crown, following the said boundary to the Southern end of Paparauponga; thence striking off towards the Kape-Kape, and on to Te Ahibura; thence descending to Te Pa-hoahoa on the Whareroa stream, and following the said stream to its mouth, excepting the following reserves:—

PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, ESQUIRE, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS in the Fourth Session of the Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington, a Committee of the said Council was appointed—"To enquire into the past, present, and proposed Government arrangements for the promotion of Immigration and to report thereon; and, also whether any improvements could be suggested whereby a large

amount of Immigration of an equally desirable description could be secured at less cost to the Provincial Revenue."

AND WHEREAS such Committee made their report which on being brought up was adopted by the said Council.

AND WHEREAS the Committee by their Report recommended that a remission of twenty-five per cent of the whole amount of the passage money to the Immigrant, upon payment of the balance of his promissory note given for the passage money, should be allowed; and the said Committee also proposed that such remission should be made in land and urged upon the Council to recommend to the Government that an amount of available land should be reserved to satisfy the claims.

AND WHEREAS by the "Additional Land Regulations of 1855, it is provided that" All Reserves for the sites of townships or town and suburban land, for the sites of agricultural and small farm settlements, or for any other purpose of public advantage, safety, convenience, health or enjoyment shall be determined by the Superintendent, who shall notify the same by Proclamation, wherein the objects shall be specified for which every reserve may be made.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the block of land hereinafter described should be reserved from sale in order to enable the Superintendent to carry out the Recommendation of the said Council: NOW THEREFORE I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, Do hereby Proclaim that the Block of Land situate in the District of the Three Mile Bush comprised within the following boundaries, namely:—On the North by a straight line running from the Three Mile Bush road Eastwards eighty chains, commencing and partly running along the Southern boundary of Section, No. 142; on the Eastward by a straight line eighty chains from and parallel to the Three Mile Bush road; on the Southward by a straight line eighty chains in length from last line to Three Mile Bush road; and on the Westward by the Three Mile Bush road,—is reserved for the purpose of satisfying the claims to be made in pursuance of the recommendation of the Committee of the Provincial Council above referred to.
