PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, ESQUIRE, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington in the Islands of New Zealand.

I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington in pursuance of the Regulations in this behalf do hereby Proclaim and Notify that the Sections of land in the Ahiaruhe Block in the Wairarapa District of the Province of Wellington, specified in the Schedule hereto, except such as may be reserved under the provision hereafter mentioned will be put up for sale by Public Auction, at the Crown Lands Office in the town of Wellington, on Wednesday the fourth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, at one o'clock in the afternoon.

Fly Bay } West, E. $\frac{1}{4}$ S.

Bearing of Luke Rock from Buoy, N.W.

—about one-fifth mile.

This Rock being of great extent strangers are cautioned against standing into Fly Bay, between the Buoy and the bearings given.
