I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby proclaim and declare, that that part of the Rangitikei district which is bounded as hereinafter described, shall henceforth be a Road District, within the meaning of the Act or Acts now in force, for the construction and management of District Roads, and shall be called the "Upper Rangitikei District."

The said District being bounded on the East, by the Rangitikei River; on the North, by the boundary line of the land purchased from the Natives in the Rangitikei District; on the West by section LXI (on the District Map) thence by the Western boundaries of sections LV and LXXVII, to section XI, from thence South, to section LXXXIII, to the Rangitikei River.
