PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor Isaac Earl Featherston, Esq., Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby in pursuance of the Regulations in this behalf, proclaim and notify that the several allotments of land situate in the Wainui-omata district in the Province of Wellington, and specified in the schedule hereto, except such as may be reserved under the provision hereafter mentioned, will be put up for sale by public auction at the Crown Lands Office in the town of Wellington, on Tuesday, the twenty-fifth day of August, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, at one o'clock in the afternoon.

If at any time during the sale, it may appear to the Commissioner of Crown Lands beneficial or expedient for the public service to reserve from sale either of the sections specified in the said Schedule or vary the order in which they are to be put up, he is hereby authorised to do so.
