14, of the Provincial Council of Wellington, entitled "Harbor Reserves," and of an Act, Session VIII, No. 3, of the said Provincial Council, entitled "Harbor Reserves Amendment," and of an Act, Session XIII, No. 3, of the said Provincial Council, entitled "Reclaimed Land." Notice is hereby given that the allotments of land enumerated in the Schedule hereunto annexed, situate in the Town of Wellington, will be offered for sale at public auction, at Osgood's Long Room, Empire Hotel, on THURSDAY, the 6th day of NOVEMBER, 1866, at 1 o'clock p.m., at the upset prices affixed in the Schedule.

Immediate payment in cash of one-tenth of the purchase money shall be the condition of any such sale by auction, and the remaining nine-tenths of the purchase money must be paid by the purchaser within one calendar month next after the time of such sale by auction, or the one-tenth of the purchase money which has been deposited will be forfeited, and the original contract for the sale of the land will thenceforward be null and void.

The Government reserves to itself the right of, at any time, withdrawing and altering the size of any of the allotments.
