PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor Isaac Earl Featherston Esquire Superintendent of the Province of Wellington in the Islands of New Zealand.

I ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON Superintendent of the Province of Wellington by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me in this behalf do hereby proclaim and declare that the parts of the said Province lying within the limits hereinafter specified shall form and constitute a district for the purpose of the District Highways Acts namely Bounded on the North and West by the Hutt road On the East by the Hutt river and on the South by the Harbour of Port Nicholson and that such district shall be called the Petoni Highways District.
