day of December next, at the hour of ten
o'clock in the forenoon, and that a meet-
ing of the Creditors of the said petitioner
be held in the Grand Jury Room, Su-
preme Court House, Lambton Quay, on
the twenty-eighth day of October instant,
at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, for the
purpose of recommending Trustees for the
said Estate, and the mode of winding up
the same, and that in the meantime
William Robert Edward Brown, the In-
spector of Bankruptcy, in the Province of
Wellington, be appointed ad interim
Sequestrator of the said Estate. And it
is further ordered that this present order
be a vesting order as provided by the
Debtors and Creditors Act, 1865; pro-
vided however that nothing herein con-
tained shall protect the person of the said
Petitioner from any writ of arrest which
may issue against him under the Writ of
Arrest Act to the satisfaction of a Judge
of this Honorable Court, or a Registrar in
the absence of the Judge.
