Brunswick (Wanganui) School District.

PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Second Session of the Provincial Council of Wellington, No. 6, intituled "An Act to promote the establishment of Common Schools in the Province of Wellington" it is enacted that for the purposes of the said Act it should be lawful for the Superintendent by Proclamation to divide the Province into Districts, and from time to time to subdivide such Districts and to re-unite any sub-divisions, and also by Proclamation to declare that the said Act should come into operation within such district or sub-division at such time as he might appoint. And whereas it is deemed expedient to proclaim that portion of the province within the boundaries hereinafter set forth to be a district for the purposes of the said Act. Now therefore I, Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare

that such portion of the said Province as is comprised within the following boundaries shall form and constitute a district for the purposes of the said Act to be called the "Brunswick (Wanganui) School District."

The boundary commences at the south-east corner of section No. 131, thence along eastern boundary of said section and across a public road, thence along southern boundary of section No. 39 to its south-west corner, thence along western boundary of section No. 39 aforesaid to its north-west corner, thence along the southern boundary of section No. 131 to its south-east corner, thence along eastern boundary of section No. 131 aforesaid, and sections Nos. 134, 135, 136, 137, 138, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, and 209, until it meets the south-western boundary of section 207, thence along said boundary line to south-western corner of said section, thence along north-western boundaries of section No. 207 aforesaid, and section No. 204, thence along northern boundary of said section No. 204 to south-western corner of section purchased by Charles Smith, thence along north-western boundary of said section until it intersects the boundary of Native Lands, thence towards the north-west along boundary between Native Lands and purchased lands until the said boundary line intercepts the Great

North-western Road near W. E. Gud-
geon's 50 acre purchase, thence towards
the south-west along the said Great
North-western line of Road to the starting
point.

And also that the said Act shall come
into operation within such District on
the day of the date hereof.

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Second
~~Session of the Provincial Council~~
of Wellington, No. 6, intituled "An Act
to Promote the Establishment of Common
Schools in the Province of Wellington,"
it is enacted that, for the purposes of
said Act, it should be lawful for the Su-
perintendent by Proclamation to divide
the Province into Districts and from
time to time to sub-divide such Districts
and to re-unite any sub-divisions. And
also, by Proclamation, to declare that the
said Act should come into operation
within such District or sub-division at
such time as he might appoint. And
whereas it is deemed expedient to
proclaim that portion of the Province
within the boundaries hereinafter set
forth to be a District for the purposes
of the said Act. Now therefore I, Isaac
Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the
Province of Wellington, in virtue of the
power and authority vested in me in this
behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare
that such portion of the said Province as
is comprised within the following bound-
aries shall form and constitute a Dis-
trict for the purposes of the said Act to
be called the Kai Warra Warra School
District.

The boundary commences at the north
west corner of section No. 9, Harbor
District thence, along northern bound-
ary of said section to high water mark
of Port Nicholson, thence along the beach

until it meets the northern boundary of
the Town Belt of Wellington, thence
along northern and eastern boundaries of
said Town Belt to the north east corner
of section No. 30 Kai Warra Warra
District, thence along the northern bound-
ary of said section No. 30 and of sections
Nos. 31 and 33 of Kai Warra Warra
District until it intersects the southern
boundary of a district known as Rhodes'
Highway District, thence along southern
and western boundaries of said district
as far as the south west corner of section
No. 7 of the Kai Warra Warra District,
thence along western boundary of said
section No. 7 to its point of intersection
with the southern boundary of section
No. 9 of said District of Kai Warra
Warra thence along the southern, western
and northern boundaries of said section
No. 9, thence along western boundaries
of unappropriated land and of sections
Nos. 1 and 2 of the Porirua District,
thence along northern boundary of section
No. 2 aforesaid to its intersection with
western boundary of said section No. 6
Harbor District, thence along western
boundary of the said section No. 6
and of section No. 7 to its intersection
with southern boundary of section No. 8
thence along southern and western bound-
aries of said section No. 8, and of
western boundary of section No. 9 to the
starting point.

And also that the said Act shall come
into operation within such district on the
day of the date hereof.

Foxton Highway District.

PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL
FEATHERSTON, Esq., Superin-
tendent of the Province of
Wellington, in the Islands of
New Zealand.

I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON,
Superintendent of the Province of
Wellington, in virtue of the powers vested
in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim
and declare that the parts of the Province
lying within the limits hereinafter specified

shall form and constitute a District for the purposes of the District Highway's Act, namely: The boundary commences on the bank of the Manawatu River at the North West corner of Rural Section No. 530, Township of Foxton, thence along the Northern boundary of said Section across a public road, and along Northern and Eastern boundaries of Section No. 529, thence eastward across a public road, and along Northern and Eastern boundaries of Section No. 411, and across a public road to its intersection with Northern boundary line of Section No. 419, thence along Northern boundary line of said Section, and of Sections Nos. 428, 429, 430, 431, 432, 433, and 434, thence along Eastern boundary of Section No. 434, across a public road, and along Eastern boundary of Section No. 535, to the Manawatu River, thence along the Northern and Eastern banks of said River, to the starting point.

As the said District and limits hereby proclaimed are more particularly delineated and described in the plan drawn or endorsed hereon and thereon colored red.

And such Highway District shall be called the "Foxton Highway District."

WELLINGTON DISTRICT.

Allan, of counsel for the petitioner, it is ordered that the said petition be accepted, and that the said petitioner do come up for hearing at the Supreme Court House at Wellington, on Saturday, the fourteenth (14th) day of December next, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, and that a meeting of the Creditors of the said petitioner be held in the Grand Jury Room, at Wellington, on Thursday, the fifth day of December next, at the hour of eleven o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of recommending Trustees for the said Estate, and the mode of winding up the same, and that in the meantime Edward William Mills, of Wellington, be appointed Sequestrator of the Estate and Effects of the Petitioner. And it is hereby ordered that this order be a vesting order in accordance with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Act, 1865. And it is hereby ordered that the person of the said Petitioner and his goods and chattels shall be protected from all process of arrest and execution save only against any which may be issued against him under the Writ of Arrest Act to the satisfaction of a Judge of this Honorable Court, or of a Registrar thereof in the absence of such Judge.
