*Alteration of Boundaries of the  
Carterton School District.*

PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by a certain Proclamation by His Honor Isaac Earl Featherston, as such Superintendent as aforesaid, dated the eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, a certain portion of the District of the Wairarapa, in the Province of Wellington, was declared to be a School District under the name of the Carterton School District, and under the provisions of an Act of the Provincial Council, Session II, No. 6, and whereas it is expedient to alter the boundaries of the said School District in manner herein-after mentioned. Now therefore I, Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that such portion of the said Province as is comprised within the following boundaries shall form a District for the purposes of the said Act, to be called the Carterton School District, and that the said Act shall come into operation in the said District on the day of the date hereof.

Commencing at the junction of the Mungataurera Stream with the Waiohine River, thence up the Maungataurera Stream until it meets a line being a continuation of the Southern boundary of Sections 172, 145, 171, 89, and 1, Taratahi Plain Block, thence along the said line to the South Eastern corner of Section No. 1,

Taratahi Plain Block, thence on a Magnetic Bearing of  $215^{\circ} 31'$  until it strikes the Waiohine River, thence up the Waiohine River to the starting point.

*Alteration of Boundaries of the  
Township of Carterton.*

PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the boundaries of the Township of Carterton, in the District of the Wairarapa, in the Province of Wellington, as proclaimed in the Provincial Government Gazette of the Province of Wellington, dated the twenty-seventh day of July, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine, should be altered so that the said boundaries should correspond with the boundaries of the Carterton School District. Now therefore I, the said Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby proclaim and declare in virtue of the power and authority in me vested in that behalf, that such portion of the said Province as is comprised within

the following boundaries shall from the date of this proclamation constitute the Township of Carterton.

Commencing at the Junction of the Mungataurera Stream with the Waiohine River, thence up the Mungataurera Stream until it meets a line being a continuation of the Southern Boundary of Sections 172, 145, 171, 89, and 1, Taratahi Plain Block, thence along the said line to the South Eastern corner of Section No. 1, Taratahi Plain Block, thence on a magnetic bearing of  $215^{\circ} 31'$  until it strikes the Waiohine River, thence up the Waiohine River to the starting point.

### *Alteration of Boundaries of the Featherston Highway District.*

#### PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS a certain Highway District called the Featherston Highway District was proclaimed as such in the Provincial Government *Gazette* of the Province of Wellington, No. 2, dated the eighteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four. And whereas it is expedient to alter the boundaries of the said District in manner hereinafter mentioned, due notice of such alteration having been given in manner required by law. Now therefore I, Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby, in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, proclaim and declare that the parcel of land comprised within the following boundaries shall from the date hereof be considered as no longer within the boundaries of the said Highway District.

The Boundary commences at the South Western Corner of Section No. 463, Featherston Highway District, thence along the Southern boundary of said Section to its South East corner, thence along its Eastern boundary to the Owahanga River, thence along said River to the Wairarapa Lake, thence South Westerly along the banks of the Wairarapa Lake to the Wairongomai Bush, thence along the Northern boundary of said Bush to the Remutaka Hills, thence along said hills to the starting point.
