PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL

of New Zealand.

I, ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON,  
Superintendent of the Province of  
Wellington, in pursuance of the power  
vested in me by Clause II of the Additional  
Land Regulations, of the fifteenth day of  
February, one thousand eight hundred and  
fifty-five, do hereby proclaim and notify  
that the block of land situate in the East  
Coast District, and comprised within the  
following boundaries, viz:—The boundary  
commences at the North West corner of  
Section No. 1, thence Easterly to its North  
East corner, thence South Easterly along  
the North East boundaries of Sections  
Nos. 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25,  
26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 183,  
184, 185, 186, 187, 188, 189, and 190,  
thence South Westerly along the South  
East boundaries of Sections Nos. 190, 175,  
174, and 159, thence North Westerly  
along the South West boundaries of Sec-  
tions Nos. 159 and 160, thence South  
Westerly along the South East boundary  
of Section No. 158, thence North Wes-  
terly along the South West boundaries of  
Sections Nos. 158, 157, 156, 155, 154, and  
153, thence North Easterly along the North

thence down the Ihuraua River to its junc-  
tion with the Te Hoe River, thence down  
the Te Hoe River till it meets the North  
West boundary of William Fisher's selec-  
tion of fifty acres, thence along the said  
North West boundary and its North East  
boundary to the Eastern corner of the said  
William Fisher's selection, thence in a  
straight line to the starting point; com-  
puted to contain about ten thousand one  
hundred and forty-four (10,144) acres, and  
which said boundaries are particularly  
delineated in the plan annexed hereto,  
shall be reserved as a site for a Small Farm  
Settlement, and be known as the township  
of Alfredton.

### Boundaries of Makara School District.

#### PROCLAMATION.

By HIS HONOR ISAAC EARL FEATHERSTON, Esquire, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Islands of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Second Session of the Provincial Council of Wellington, No. 6, intituled "An Act to promote the establishment of Common Schools in the Province of Wellington," it is enacted that for the purposes of the said Act it should be lawful for the Superintendent by proclamation to divide the Province into Districts, and from time to time to subdivide such Districts and to re-unite any subdivisions; and also by proclamation to declare that the said Act should come into operation within such District or subdivision at such times as he might appoint. And whereas it is expedient to proclaim that portion of the Province within the boundaries hereinafter set forth to be a district for the purposes of the said Act. Now therefore I, Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that such portion of the said Province as is comprised within the following boundaries shall form and constitute a District for the purposes of the said Act, to be called "The Makara School District".

The Boundary commences at the South East corner of Section No. 1, South Makara District, thence Westerly along the Southern Boundary of said Section to its South Western corner, thence Northwardly along the Western Boundaries of Sections Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4; thence Westerly along part of the Southern Boundary of Section No. 5 to its South West corner, thence Northwardly along the Western boundary of said Section to its North West corner, thence westerly along part of the Southern boundary of Section No. 7 to its South West corner, thence Northwardly along the Western boundaries of Sections Nos. 7, 9, 11, 15, 17, 19, and 21, thence

Northwesterly in a straight line to the North East corner of Section No. 28, Terawiti District, thence along the North Eastern boundary of said Section to the Sea Coast, thence Northwardly along the Sea Coast to the intersection of the production of the Northern boundaries of Sections Nos. 70 and 68, North Makara District, thence Easterly along the said line to the North-east corner of Section No. 68, thence Southwardly along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 68, 69, 97, 77, 78, 79, and 84 thence along part of the Southern boundary of Section No. 84 to the North-east corner of Section No. 85, thence along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 85, 86, 87, thence along part of the Southern boundary of Section No. 87 to the North-east corner of Section No. 38, thence along the Eastern boundaries of Sections No. 38, 36, 34, 32 and 30, thence along the Northern boundary of Section No. 40, thence along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 40 and 41, thence along the South-eastern boundary of Sections Nos. 41, 43, and 44, thence along the Southern boundary of Section No. 44, thence along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 3, 2, 1, South Makara District to the starting point.

And also, that the said Act shall come into operation within such district on the day of the date hereof.

*Boundaries of Horokiwi and Pahautanui School District.*

PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Second Session of the Provincial Council of Wellington, No. 6, intituled "An Act to promote the establishment of Common Schools in the Province of Wellington," it is enacted that for the purposes of the said Act it should be lawful for the Superintendent by proclamation to divide the Province into Districts, and from time to time to subdivide such Districts, and to re-unite any subdivisions; and also by proclamation to declare that the said Act should come into operation within such district or subdivision at such time as he might appoint. And whereas it is deemed expedient to proclaim that portion of the Province within the boundaries hereinafter set forth to be a district for the purposes of the said Act. Now therefore I, Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, do

hereby proclaim and declare that such portion of the said Province as is comprised within the following boundaries shall form and constitute a District for the purposes of the said Act, to be called the "Horokiwi Valley School District," and the boundaries of the Pahautanui School District are hereby altered accordingly.

The Boundary commences at the North Western corner of Section No 85, Pahautanui District, thence North Easterly in a straight line to the North West corner of Section No. 20, Horokiwi Valley District, thence along the Western boundaries of Sections Nos. 23, 24, 27, 28, and 31, thence along part of the Northern boundary of Section No. 31, to the South West corner of Section No. 32, thence along the Western boundaries of Sections Nos. 32 and 35, thence along part of the Southern boundary of Section No. 36 to its South West corner, thence along the Western boundary of Section No. 36, thence along part of the Southern boundary of Section No. 39 to its South West corner, thence along the Western boundary of said Section No. 39, thence along part of the Southern boundary of Section No. 40 to its South West corner, thence along the Western boundary of said Section to its North West corner, thence along part of the Northern boundary of said Section to the South Western corner of Section No. 43, thence along the Western boundary of said Section, thence along the Northern boundaries of Sections Nos. 43 and 42, thence along the Eastern boundary of said Section No. 42, thence along the Southern boundary of said Section No. 42 to the North East corner of Section No. 41, thence along the Eastern boundary of said Section, thence along part of the Northern boundary of Section No. 38 to its North East corner, thence along the Eastern boundary of said Section, thence along part of the Northern boundary of Section No. 34 to its North East corner, thence along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 34, 33, 30, thence along part of the Southern boundary of said Section No. 30, to the North East corner of Section No. 29, thence along the Eastern boundaries of Sections Nos. 29, 26, 25, 22, 21, 18, 17, to the South East corner of Section No. 17, thence South Westerly in a straight line towards the North East corner of Section No. 25, Pahautanui District, until it intersects the production of the Southern boundaries of Sections Nos. 4 and 5, Horokiwi Valley District, thence Easterly along said line to the starting point.

And also that the said Act shall come into operation within such District on the day of the date hereof.
