TO HOLDERS OF DEBENTURES OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF WELLINGTON.

Wellington, 5th June, 1868.

WHEREAS, an Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington, Session I, No. 6, was passed, intituled "An Act to authorize the Superintendent to raise a Loan for carrying on certain Public Works of the Province, and for other purposes;" And Whereas under and by virtue of the authority of the said Act, the sum of £50,000 was raised for the purposes in the said Act mentioned; And Whereas it is expedient that notice should be given in accordance with the sixth section of the said Act, that the debentures for the said loan of £50,000 should be paid off:

Now therefore I, John Hall, acting for the Colonial Treasurer of New Zealand, do hereby, on behalf of the Government of New Zealand, and I, Isaac Earl Featherston, Superintendent of the said Province, do hereby, on behalf of the Government of the said Province, give notice that all debentures issued under the said Act shall become payable at the Colonial Treasury, Wellington, New Zealand, on the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
