PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the Land Regulations now in force in the Province of Wellington it is declared that all Reserves for the sites of Townships or Suburban Lands for the sites of Agricultural and Small Farm Settlements or for any other purpose of public advantage safety convenience health or enjoyment shall be determined by the Superintendent who shall notify the same by Proclamation wherein the object shall be specified for which any reserve shall be made AND WHEREAS it would be of public advantage if certain land in the Township of FOXTON in the Manawatu District was set apart for a Race Course NOW THEREFORE I Isaac Earl Featherston Superintendent of the Province of Wellington in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf Do HEREBY PROCLAIM and declare that Rural Section No. 537 (five hundred and thirty-seven) in the Township of Foxton in the District of Manawatu containing 85 (eighty-five) acres more or less bounded on the North by Rural Section No. 477 (four hundred and seventy-seven) South and East by a Public Road and West by Rural Section No. 476 (four hundred and seventy-six) is hereby reserved and set apart by me for the purpose aforesaid.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of Wellington of the Province of Wellington Session III No. 8 intituled "An Act to amend and consolidate the law relating to Cattle Trespass and Impounding" it is enacted that the Superintendent of the said Province may
