I hereby certify that I have this day examined Three hundred and forty Wethers in possession of Major J. T. Edwards, A., Tar brand on the rump; at the yards adjoining the homestead, and and to the best of my belief they are free from Scab, and further that Major Edwards informs me that the same sheep have been

a portion of a separate flock since April last, and that they have not been mixed with any infected Sheep—and further that no dressing has been put on them since about the month of June.
