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PROCLAMATION.

By His Honor WILLIAM FITZHERBERT, Esquire,  
Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the  
Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington, shortly intituled "The Highways Act, 1871," it enacted that so much of the said Province of Wellington as is included in the several Districts therein mentioned, viz.:—Wanganui and Waitotara, Wangaehu, Rangitikei, Manawatu, Featherston, Castle Point, Wellington, and Masterton, shall be divided into the said several Highway Districts, the boundaries whereof are set forth in the second schedule to the said Act.

And whereas it is further enacted by the said Act that each of the before-mentioned Highway Districts shall be divided into Wards by the Superintendent with the advice of his Executive Council, who shall from time to time by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, define the boundaries of such Wards. Provided that the number of Wards in any District shall never be less than seven:

Now, therefore, I, WILLIAM FITZHERBERT, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council thereof, do hereby, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the said above recited Act, proclaim and declare that each of the several Highway Districts mentioned in the schedule hereto shall be divided into Wards, the boundaries whereof are respectively set forth after the name of each such District in the said schedule hereto. And I do hereby, with the like advice and consent, define the said boundaries, and declare the same to be the boundaries of the said several Wards respectively.

Given under my hand and issued under the Public Seal of the Province of Wellington, this First day of July, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.

## WANGANUI AND WAITOTARA HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

## WARD No. 1.

The boundary commences at the north-western boundary of section number 196 Okotuku Block, whence it proceeds easterly along the northern boundaries of sections numbers 196, 197, 198, and 199, and southerly along the eastern boundary of section 199, to the north side of the Ngamatu Road; thence easterly along the north side of the said road to the Kohi stream; thence southerly along the said stream to the western corner of section number 132; thence south-easterly along the southern boundaries of sections numbers 132, 126, and 125, to the eastern side of the Mangatangi road; thence southerly along the eastern sides of the said road, and of the Wairoa township, to the south side of the Weraroa road; thence westerly along the said south side of the Weraroa road, to the eastern side of the Oturi road; thence southerly and south-westerly along the eastern and north-eastern sides of the Oturi and Ihupuku roads to the Wairoa stream; thence southerly along the said stream to the sea coast; thence north-westerly along the shore of Cook's Strait to the north-western boundary of the Province of Wellington; thence north-easterly along the said boundary line of the Province to the starting point.

## WARD No. 2.

The boundary commences at a point where the northern side of the Momahaki road strikes the Kohi stream; from thence it proceeds south-westerly along the northern side of the said road, to the west side of the Okotuku road; thence northerly along the western side of the said Okotuku road to the north-west corner of section number 74; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said section and its production to the Momuhuki stream; thence south-easterly along the said stream to the Waitotara river; thence southerly and south-westerly along the said river to the sea-coast; thence westerly along the shore of Cook's Strait to the Wairoa Stream; and thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Ward No. 1 to the starting point.

## WARD No. 3.

The boundary commences at a point on the left bank of the Waitotara river, where the northern boundary line of the Waitotara purchased block strikes it; from thence it proceeds easterly along the said northern boundary line of the Waitotara purchase block, to the north-east corner of Native Reserve number 2; thence southerly to the south-east corner of section number 59, so as to include within its limits the said Native Reserve number 2, and sections numbers 43, 44, 61, 60, and 59; thence turning westerly along the shore of Cook's Strait to the mouth of the Waitotara river; and thence northerly along the left bank of the Waitotara river to the starting point.

## WARD No. 4.

The boundary commences at the north-east corner of Native Reserve number 2, Waitotara Block; thence it proceeds easterly along the northern boundary lines of the Waitotara purchased block, of the Kai Iwi block, and of the Kaiwatu and Koatanui block, to the Mungaone stream; thence southerly along the said stream, along the Kai Iwi stream, and along the western boundary line of the Wanganui purchased block to the sea; thence turning westerly along the shore of Cook's Strait to the south-east corner of section number 59 (Waitotara Block); and thence northerly along the eastern boundary lines of Ward number 3 to the starting point.

## WARD No. 5.

The boundary commences at the north-western corner of section number 241, right bank Wanganui River; from thence it proceeds easterly to the eastern corner of section number 15, so as to include within its limits sections numbers 241, 245, 239, 244, 170, 157, 156, 91, 90, 89, 108, 85, 84, 83, 82, 81, 80, and 15; thence it proceeds southerly and easterly along the western and southern boundary lines of the Wanganui Town Belt to the River Wanganui; thence along the bank of the said river to its mouth; thence westerly along the shore of Cook's Strait to the mouth of the Mowhanau Stream; and from thence northerly along the western boundary line of the Wanganui purchased block to the starting point.

## WARD No. 6.

The boundary commences at the junction of the Ohura Stream with the Wanganui River; thence it proceeds southerly along the right bank of the said river to the northern boundary line of section number 202; thence southerly to the north-

east corner of section number 108, so as to include within its limits sections numbers 203, 204, and 207; also the application of S. Gray, for 115 acres; the Ngaturi Native Reserve, and sections numbers 70, 61, 136, 135, 112, 111, 110, and 109; thence it proceeds westerly along the northern boundary of Ward number 5 to the western boundary line of the Wanganui purchased block; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Ward number 4 to the northern boundary line of the same; thence westerly along the northern boundary lines of Wards numbers 4, 3, 2, and 1, to the north-western boundary line of the Province; and thence north-easterly along the said boundary line of the Province to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 7.

The boundary commences at the northern corner of section number 202, right bank, Wanganui River; thence it proceeds southerly along the right bank of the said river to the north-east boundary line of the Wanganui Town Belt; thence north-westerly and south-westerly along the boundary lines of the said Town Belt to the eastern corner of section number 15; thence north-westerly along the north-east boundary line of Ward number 5 to the south corner of section number 108; and thence northerly along the eastern boundary of said section number 108, and along the eastern boundary lines of Ward number 6 to the starting point.

### WANGAEHU HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

#### WARD No. 1.

The boundary commences on the bank of the Wanganui River at the north-west corner of Campbell Town; thence it proceeds easterly along the northern boundary and southerly along the eastern boundary of the said town to the south side of number 2 road line; thence easterly along the south side of the said road line to the north-east corner of section number 33; then southerly in a straight line to the south-west corner of section number 34; thence easterly in a straight line to the north-east corner of section number 107; thence southerly in a straight line to the south-west corner of section number 146; thence easterly in a straight line to the south-east corner of section number 147; thence northerly and easterly, so as to include section number 251; from the north-east corner of the said section number 251, it turns southerly to the Wangaehu River, including sections numbers 251 and 290; thence it proceeds south-westerly along the right bank of the said river to the sea coast; thence north-westerly along the shore of Cooks' Strait to the mouth of the Wanganui River; and thence north-easterly along the left bank of the said river to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 2.

The boundary commences at the south-east corner of section number 42; whence it proceeds northerly along the eastern boundary of the said section and its production to the north side of number 2 road line; thence easterly along the north side of the said road line to the south-east corner of section number 194; thence northerly to the south-west corner of section number 247; thence easterly along the northern boundary of section number 248 to the River Wangaehu; thence south-westerly along the right bank of the said river to the south-east corner of section number 290; and thence along the eastern boundaries of Ward number 1 to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 3.

The boundary commences at the south-west corner of the Waipakura Native Reserve, whence it proceeds westerly along the south boundary of the said reserve to the source of the Kuku Stream; thence south-easterly in a straight line to the north corner of section number 295; thence southerly to the south-east corner of section number 42, so as to include within its limits sections numbers 295, 293, 292, 272, 116, 115, 114, 113, 112, 57, and 42; thence westerly along the northern boundaries of Ward number 1 to the Wanganui River; and thence northerly along the left bank of the said river to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 4.

The boundary commences at a point on the Wanganui River where the north-east boundary line of the Upokongoro Block number 1 strikes it; whence it proceeds southerly to the north-east corner of Ward number 3, so as to include Upokongoro

Block number 1, section number 280, and the Waipakura Native Reserve; thence westerly along the Kukutu Stream to the River Wanganui; thence it proceeds northerly along the left bank of the said River Wanganui to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 5.

The boundary commences at a point on the Wanganui River, where the north-east boundary line of Upokongoro Block number 1 strikes it; thence it proceeds northerly along the left bank of the Rivers Wanganui and Ngarue to the northern boundary of the Province of Wellington; thence easterly along the said boundary line to the Upper Waikato River; thence southerly along the left bank of the said river to its source; thence in a straight line to the source of the river Wangaehu; thence southerly along the right bank of the said river to the Otaika Block; thence westerly along the northern boundary lines of the Wanganui purchased block and the Makirikiri Stream to the south-west corner of section number 279; thence northerly along the eastern boundary lines of Ward number 4, to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 6.

The boundary commences at the north-east corner of the Waipakura Native Reserve, whence it proceeds easterly along the southern boundaries of Ward number 5 to the River Wangaehu; thence southerly along the right bank of the said river to the north-western corner of section number 245; thence westerly in a straight line to the eastern corner of the Waikupa Native Reserve; thence north-westerly along the north-east boundary of the said reserve to the Kaukatea stream; thence westerly along the said stream till it intersects a line bearing east, magnetic from the south-east corner of section number 292; thence westerly along such line to the eastern boundary of Ward number 3; and thence northerly along the eastern boundary lines of Wards numbers 3 and 4, to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 7.

Bounded towards the north by Ward number 6; towards the east by the right bank of the Wangaehu River; towards the south by Ward number 2; and towards the west by Ward number 3.

### RANGITIKEI HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

#### WARD No. 1.

Bounded towards the north and north-east by lines so as to include blocks numbers CXVII, CXVIII, CXIX, CXX, CXXI, CXXII, CXXIII, CXXIV, CXXV, CXXVI, and CXXVII, sections numbers 44, 43, 38, and 36, blocks numbers 268, 269, 271, and section number 36A, Rangitikei District; towards the south-east by the Rangitikei River; towards the south-west by the shore of Cook's Strait; and towards the north-west by lines so as to include blocks numbers CXVII, CLXV, and CLXVII, and by a line being the production of the north-west boundary line of the last-named block to the shore of Cook's Strait.

#### WARD No. 2.

Bounded towards the north by the Turakina River, by the Makirikiri Stream, and by lines so as to include sections numbers 25, 23, 21, 19, 17, 43, 45, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, and 52, Turakina District; towards the east by lines so as to include sections numbers 56, 57, 57A, and 58, Turakina District; towards the south-east by lines so as to include block number XCIX, and by the north-west boundary lines of Ward number 1, and towards the south-west by the shore of Cook's Strait.

#### WARD No. 3.

Bounded towards the north by lines so as to include sections numbers 34, 35, 36, 40, 41, 42, 45, 46, 51, 52, 53, 55, and 12, and block number VI, Rangitikei District; towards the south-east by the Rangitikei River; towards the south by the northern boundary line of Ward number 1; towards the south-west by the north-eastern boundary lines of Ward number 1, and towards the north-west and west by the south-east boundary lines of Ward number 2.

## WARD No. 4.

Bounded towards the north by lines so as to include blocks numbers CXCIV, CXCIV, LXXI, LXXIII, LXXVA, LXXXI, LXV, XXXIII, XXXVIII, and VIII, Rangitikei District; towards the east by the Porewa Stream and by the Rangitikei River; towards the south by north boundary lines of Wards numbers 2 and 3, and towards the west by the west boundary lines of sections numbers 31, 30, 23, and 22, and of blocks numbers LXIII, LXIX, LXX, and CXCIV.

## WARD No. 5.

Bounded towards the north-east by the north-east boundary lines of the Ruatangata Block, by the Turakina River, and by the Waimutu Stream; towards the east by the west boundary of Ward number 4; towards the south by the north boundary of Ward number 2; towards the south-west by the shore of Cook's Strait; and towards the north-west by the River Wangaeahu.

## WARD No. 6.

Bounded towards the north-east by the north-east boundary of the Rangitikei District, and the production of the said north-east boundary line to the Wangaeahu River; towards the east by lines so as to include blocks numbers CCXLVII, CCXLVI, CCXXXI, CCLIX, CCLI, CCL, CCXII, CCLXXVI, and LXVI; towards the south by the north boundary lines of Wards numbers 4 and 5, and towards the west by the River Wangaeahu.

## WARD No. 7.

Bounded towards the north, the east, and the south-east by the boundaries of the Rangitikei Highway District; towards the south by the north boundary lines of Ward number 4; and towards the west and south-west by the boundary lines of Ward number 6, and by the Wangaeahu and Waikato Rivers.

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**MANAWATU HIGHWAY DISTRICT.**

## WARD No. 1.

Bounded towards the north by the Rangitikei River, and by a line east magnetic from the source of the said river to the summits of the Ruahine Range; towards the east and the south-east by the summits of the Ruahine Range, by the north boundary of Ward number 6, and by the Oroua River; towards the south by the northern boundary of the Township of Carnarvon; and towards the west by the Rangitikei River.

## WARD No. 2.

The boundaries of this Ward are the same as those of the Township of Carnarvon, which are as follows:—

Commencing at Pakenahau, where the northern boundary of the block purchased from the natives, and called the Awahou Block, leaves the Manawatu River, and following the said boundary to Pukehinau and Omara Papaku and onwards to the sea coast; thence by the sea coast in a northerly direction to the mouth of the Rangitikei River; thence along the left bank of that river to the intersection of the southern boundary of the Mangamahoi Native Reserve; thence along said southern boundary to its south-east corner; thence along its eastern boundary to a point opposite the south side line of a public road bounding the Hutt Small Farm Block; thence south-easterly across a public road and along the south side line of the public road aforesaid to a point opposite the south-eastern boundary of the Hutt Small Farm Block; thence north-easterly across the said public road and along the south-eastern boundary of the Hutt Small Farm Block until it intersects the main road line from Palmerston to Wanganui; thence along the south side of the said main road line to the Oroua River; thence along the right bank of the said river to its junction with the Manawatu River; thence along the right bank of the Manawatu River to the starting point at Pakenahau.

## WARD No. 3.

The boundaries of this Ward are the same as those of the Township of Foxton, which are as follows:—

Commencing at Pakenahau, where the northern boundary of the block purchased from the natives, and called the Awahou Block, leaves the Manawatu River, and following the said boundary to Pukehinau and Omara Papaku, and onwards to the sea coast; thence by the sea coast in a southerly direction to the mouth of the Manawatu River; thence along the northern bank of the River Manawatu to the starting point at Pakenahau.

## WARD No. 4.

Bounded towards the north-east by lines so as to include sections 374, 373, 372, 371, 370, 317, 316, 290, 289, and 288, Township of Palmerston, by a line from the south-east corner of section number 421, to the south-east corner of section number 447, by the same line produced to the Oroua River, by the Manawatu River, by the Kahuterawa Stream, and by a line bearing east magnetic from the source of the Kahuterawa Stream to the summit of the Tararua Range; towards the south-east by the summit of the Tararua Range; towards the south-west by the Manawatu River and by the south boundary lines of the Township of Fitzherbert, from the point where the south-west boundary of the Ahuataranga Block leaves the Manawatu River, and crosses in a south-easterly direction to the summit of the Tararua Ranges; and towards the west by the Oroua River.

## WARD No. 5.

Bounded towards the north-east by a line from the north-east corner of section number 422, township of Palmerston, to the north-west corner of section number 446, by the same line produced to the Oroua River, and by lines so as to include sections numbers 246, 247, 248, 249, 251, 250, 177, 176, and 387, by the Manawatu River, and by a line bearing 135° magnetic from the north corner of Te Wi Native Reserve to the summit of the Tararua Range; towards the south-east by the summit of the Tararua Range; towards the south-west by the north-east boundary lines of Ward number 4, and towards the north-west by the Oroua River.

## WARD No. 6.

Bounded towards the north by the Oroua River, and by a line bearing east magnetic from the source of the said river to the summit of the Ruahine Range; towards the east by the summit of the Ruahine and Tararua Ranges; towards the south-west by the north-east boundary lines of Ward number 5; and towards the north-west by the Oroua River.

## WARD No. 7.

Bounded towards the north-east by the Manawatu River, and by the south west boundary of Ward number 4; towards the east by the summit of the Tararua Ranges; towards the south-east by the south-west boundaries of the Manawatu Highways District, between the summit of the Tararua Range and the mouth of the Waikanae River; and towards the north-west by the sea coast.

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**FEATHERSTON HIGHWAY DISTRICT.**

## WARD No. 1.

Bounded towards the north by a line west magnetic from the source of the Waiohine River to the summit of the Tararua Ranges, and by the Waiohine River from its source to the Ruamahanga River; towards the east by the Ruamahanga River; towards the south by lines so as to include sections numbers 36, 20, 23, 24, 25, 26, 77, 75, 62, and 9, Moroa Block; and towards the west by the Tauherenikau River to its source by a line west magnetic from the source to the summit of the Tararua Ranges, and by the summit of the Tararua Ranges.

## WARD No. 2.

Bounded towards the north by a line west magnetic from the source of the Tauherenikau River to the summit of the Tararua Ranges, and by the Tauherenikau River; towards the east by the Tauherenikau River; towards the south by a stream bounding sections numbers 507 and 508, Township of Featherston Block, and running into the Wairarapa Lake, by the northern shore of the Lake, by the southern boundaries of sections numbers 512, 204, 203, 197A, and 511, Township of Featherston Block, and by lines including sections numbers 510, 462, 463, 350, and 351; and towards the west by lines including sections numbers 351, 350, and 463, and by the summits of the Rimutaka and Tararua Ranges.

## WARD No. 3.

Bounded towards the north by the south boundary of Ward number 2; towards the east by the west shore of the Wairarapa Lake, by the Ruamahanga River, and by the west shore of Oneke Lake; towards the south by the sea coast, between Oneke Lake and Taourakira Head; and towards the west by the summit of the Rimutaka Ranges.

## WARD No. 4.

Bounded towards the north by the south boundary of Ward number 1; towards the east and the south by the Ruamahanga River; and towards the west by the east shore of the Wairarapa Lake, by the stream bounding sections numbers 507 and 508, Township of Featherston Block, and running into the Lake, and by the Tauherinkau River.

## WARD No. 5.

Bounded towards the north and east by the Huangaroa River, and by a line south magnetic from the south corner of section number 22, Wharekaka Block, to a point distant about three miles; towards the south by a straight line from the said point (distant three miles from the south corner of section number 22) to the south corner of section number 46, by the south boundary of the said section number 46, and by the Orupouanui Stream; and towards the west by the Ruamahanga River.

## WARD No. 6.

Bounded towards the north by the south boundary of Ward number 5; towards the south-east by a straight line from the eastern extreme of the north boundary, to the source of the Hurupi Stream, and by the Hurupi Stream; towards the south by the sea coast between the Hurupi Stream and Oneke Lake; and towards the west by the east shore of Oneke Lake, and by the Ruamahanga River.

## WARD No. 7.

The boundary commences at the mouth of the Pahaua River, whence it proceeds southerly along the sea coast to the Hurupi Stream; thence it turns northerly along the south-east boundary of Ward number 6, and the east boundary of Ward number 5 to the junction of the Huangaroa and Wangaeahu Rivers; thence it turns easterly along the Wangaeahu River and the northern boundary of the Featherston Highways District, between the Wangaeahu River and the junction of the Kaikaikuri Creek with the Pahaua River; and thence down the Pahaua River to the starting point.

## CASTLE POINT HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

## WARD No. 1.

Bounded towards the north by the northern boundary lines of sections numbers 299, 292, and 293, Whareama Block, by a straight line from the east corner of said section number 293 to a point on the Waikarora Stream where the western boundary line of section number 744 strikes it, and by the Waikarora and Mangapakehu Streams; towards the east by the Whareama River and the Waihora Stream; towards the south by the south boundary of the Castle Point Highways District, between the south-east corner of section number 613, and the junction of the Kaumingi Stream with the Taueru River; and towards the west by the Taueru River.

## WARD No. 2.

Bounded towards the north by the south-west boundary lines of sections numbers 175, 183, and 170, Whareama Block, and by a line east magnetic from the south corner of said section number 170; towards the east and north-east by a line about north magnetic from a point on the Whareama River where the northern boundary line of section number 398 strikes it, to the south corner of section number 161, and by the Whareama River to its junction with the Mangapakeha Stream; towards the south by the north boundary of Ward number 1; and towards the west by the west boundary of the Castle Point Highways District, between sections numbers 299 and 175.

## WARD No. 3.

Bounded towards the north-east and east by the south-west boundary of Ward number 6, between the south-east corner of section number 28, Tiraumea Block, and

the south-west corner of section number 718, Whareama Block, and by the Tinui Stream from the south-west corner of said section number 718 to its junction with the Whareama River; and towards the south-west and west by the Whareama River from its junction with the Tinui Stream to a point where the north boundary line of section number 115, Whareama Block, strikes it, by a straight line between this last mentioned point on the Whareama River and the south corner of section number 161, and by lines so as to exclude from the boundary of the Ward sections numbers 161, 192, 193, 194, 195, and 196, Whareama Block, and sections numbers 31, 30, and 29, Tiraumea Block.

#### WARD No. 4.

Bounded towards the north and north-west by the north boundary of the Castle Point Highways District; towards the east by a line bearing north magnetic from the north corner of section number 28, Tiraumea Block, to the boundary of the Province, by lines so as to include sections numbers 28, 29, 30, and 31, Tiraumea Block, numbers 196, 195, 194, 193, 192, 161, and 186, Whareama Block, and by a line about south magnetic from the south corner of section number 161, to a point on the Whareama River where the north boundary line of section number 398 strikes it, towards the south by the north boundary of Ward number 2, and by the boundary of the Castle Point Highways District, from the south-west corner of section number 175 to the Manawatu River.

#### WARD No. 5.

Bounded towards the north by the south boundary of Ward number 6, between the south-west corner of section number 718 and the south-east corner of section number 724, Whareama Block; towards the east by the sea coast between the south-east corner of said section number 724, and the mouth of the Whareama River; and towards the south and west by the Whareama River and the Tinui Stream.

#### WARD No. 6.

Bounded towards the north by a line from the north corner of section number 28, Tiraumea Block, to a point on the Aohanga River, where the south-west boundary line of section number 117, Akitio Block, strikes it, and by the Aohanga River to its mouth; towards the east by the sea coast between the Aohanga River and a point where the south boundary line of section number 724, Whareama Block, strikes the shore; towards the south by lines so as to include sections numbers 724, 723, 722, 721, 720, 719, and 718, Whareama Block; and towards the south-west by the Tinui Stream between the south-west corners of sections numbers 718 and 471, by lines so as to include sections numbers 471, 472, 473, 474, 475, 476, and 477; by a straight line from a point where the south-west boundary line of section number 477 strikes the Matikona River to the south-east corner of section number 28, Tiraumea Block, and by the north-east boundary line of said section number 28.

#### WARD No 7.

Commencing at the mouth of the Aohanga River, the boundary proceeds northerly along the sea coast to the Waimata Stream; thence turning westerly along the northern boundary of the Province, until a line bearing north magnetic from the north corner of section number 28, Tiraumea Block, intersects it; thence it turns south in a straight line to the north corner of the said section number 28; thence north-easterly in a straight line to a point on the Aohanga River, where the south-west boundary of section number 117, Akitio Block, strikes this river; thence along the Aohanga River to the starting point.

### WELLINGTON HIGHWAY DISTRICT.

#### WARD No. 1.

The boundary commences at a point in Port Nicholson Harbor, where a production of the northern boundary of section number 660, Town of Wellington, strikes the shore; whence it proceeds along the shores of Lambton Harbor, Evans' Bay, Port Nicholson Harbor, and Cook's Straits, to the northern boundary of section number 98, Ohariu District; thence the boundary turns towards the starting point, so as to include within its limits the following sections numbers 98, 80, 84, 85, 86, and 87, Ohariu District,

numbers 38, 36, 34, 32, 30, 29, 40, and 41, Makara District, numbers 40, 39, 37, 35, 33, 31, and 30, Karori District, numbers 659 and 660, Town of Wellington and the Town Belt; excepting always the City of Wellington as defined in the first schedule to the "Municipal Corporations Act, 1867."

#### WARD No. 2.

The boundary commences at a point in the Porirua Harbor where a production of the north-east boundary line of section number 91, Porirua District, strikes the shore; thence it proceeds southerly, including within its limits the following sections: number 91, Porirua District, numbers 4 and 3, Pahautanui District, and number 39, Takapu District; from the south-east corner of said section number 39, it follows the western boundaries of sections numbers 348 and 344, Western Hutt District; from the south-west corner of said section number 344 it continues southerly, including within its limits sections numbers 34, 33, 32, 31, 30, 29, 28, 27, 26, 25, 24, 22, 21, 20, 16, 15, 14, 12, 11, 9, 7, and 5, Horokiwi Road District, and section number 19, Harbor District; continuing southerly along the shore of Port Nicholson Harbor till it meets a production of the northern boundary of section number 660, Town of Wellington; thence the boundary turns westerly towards Cook's Strait, excluding from its limits sections numbers 660 and 659, Town of Wellington, the Town Belt sections numbers 30, 31, 33, 35, 37, 39, and 40, Karori District, numbers 41, 40, 29, 30, 32, 34, 36, and 38, Makara District, and numbers 87, 86, 85, 84, 80, and 98, Ohariu District; the boundary now turns northerly from the western extreme of the northern boundary line of section number 98, Ohariu District, along the shores of Cook's Straits, and Porirua Harbor to the starting point.

#### WARD No. 3.

The boundary commences at a point in the Porirua Harbor, where the production of the north-east boundary line of section number 91, Porirua District, strikes the shore; thence it proceeds southerly, excluding from its limits sections number 91, Porirua District, numbers 4 and 3, Pahautanui District, and number 39, Takapu District; from the south-east corner of said section number 39 it turns easterly, excluding from its limits sections numbers 348 and 351, Western Hutt District; from the north-east corner of said section number 351 it continues on a bearing east magnetic till it intersects a north and south line magnetic, which touches the eastern boundary of D. Richard's selection of 40 acres, in the Pahautanui Agricultural Reserve; from the said point of intersection it turns north magnetic, till it strikes the northern boundary of the Wellington Highways District, when it turns westerly along the said northern boundary to the mouth of the Waikanae River, and thence along the sea coast to the starting point.

## WARD No. 7.

The boundary commences at a point on the left bank of the River Hutt, where a production of the south-west boundary line of section number 65, Hutt District, strikes it; thence it proceeds easterly, including within its limits sections numbers 67, 69, 71, 73, 74, and 233; from the south-west corner of the said section number 233 it continues in a straight line to the south-east corner of section number 232; and from thence it continues easterly along the boundaries of Ward number 5 to the east boundary of the Wellington Highways District; thence it turns northerly along the said eastern boundary of the Wellington Highways District, and along its northern boundary till it meets a north line magnetic from the source of the River Hutt; thence it turns south magnetic to the source of the River Hutt, and so proceeds along its left bank to the starting point.

include sections numbers 41, 57, 58, 59, and 60, Tupurupuru Block, by a stream bounding sections numbers 85 and 86, Tupurupuru Block, by the Wainuioru River, by the Kuamahanga River, and by a line bearing  $107^{\circ}$  magnetic from the source of the Kuamahanga River; and towards the west by the Tauheru River.

WARD No. 6.

Towards the north by the Tauheru River and by the south boundaries of Ward number 5; towards the east by a line bearing  $197^{\circ}$  magnetic from the south-east corner of Ward number 5 to the Pahaua River; towards the south by the south boundaries of the Masterton Highways District, between a point on the Pahaua River where the east boundary strikes it, and the mouth of the Huangaroa River; and towards the west by the Ruamahanga River.

WARD No. 7.

Bounded towards the north by the Whareama River; towards the east by the sea coast; towards the south by the Pahaua River; and towards the west by the east boundaries of Wards numbers 5 and 6, and by the Waihora Stream.
