*Proclamation.*

By His Honor William Fitzherbert,  
Esquire, C.M.G., Superintendent  
of the Province of Well-  
ington, in the Colony of New  
Zealand.

WHEREAS it has been notified to me under the hand of the Chairman of the Wanganui and Waitotara Highway Board, that the piece or parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto has been purchased by the said Board for the purpose of constructing thereon a road under the provisions of "The Highways Act 1871," and "The Highways Act Amendment Act 1873;" Now I, William Fitzherbert, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby proclaim the said piece or parcel of land described in the said Schedule to be a public highway for the purposes of the said "Highways Act 1871," and "The Highways Act Amendment Act 1873."

SCHEDULE.

"ALL that parcel of land containing by admeasurement two (2) acres one (1) rood and eighteen (18) perches, and being part of the section numbered forty-four (44) on the official map or plan of the Waitotara District in the Province of Wellington aforesaid, and bounded on the West by another portion of Section No. 44, from which it is divided by a straight line of fence commencing at the south side of the

Great North Western Road of Wellington Province at a point 527 links measured; Eastward along the said road from the eastern boundary of the Nukumarū Native Reserve, and running southwards a distance of 3947 links till it strikes the centre line of the road line originally intended as the course of the said North Western Road, and so shown on the original maps of the Waitotara District at a point 579 links from the eastern boundary of the said Native Reserve measured eastward along the said centre line; on the South for a distance of 71 links or thereabouts by another portion of said Section No. 44, from which it is separated by a fence running along the centre line just described; on the East by part of said section No. 44, from which it is separated for a distance of 3931 links by a line running northwards parallel to the first described line of fence at a distance of 60 links therefrom, and terminating at the south side of the Great North Western Road; and on the North for 65 links or thereabouts by the said road."

*Proclamation.*

By His Honor William Fitzherbert, Esquire, C.M.G., Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by Clause 12 of the Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council, shortly intituled "The Highways Act, 1871, Amendment Act, 1873," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Superintendent to proclaim the following clause to be in force in any Highway District, on receiving an application from the Board of Wardens of a Highway District:—  
"Whenever it shall appear to the satisfaction of any Highway Board that the weight carried on vehicles having the breadth of

their wheels of less than five inches, requires to be restricted, the Board may by notice posted in the district, or by advertisement inserted at least twice in some newspaper circulating in the district, give notice that all such vehicles will be subject to a penalty of not less than one shilling per hundred weight so carried above the weight of one ton five hundred weight on two wheels, or two tons ten hundred weight on four wheels, and that such penalty shall be recoverable at the suit of the collector or other agent appointed for that purpose by the Board: Provided for the carrying into operation of this clause the Board shall be empowered to take such steps as to them shall appear necessary for ascertaining the weight of any load, and no liability or damage shall accrue for any necessary delay in ascertaining the said weight."

And whereas it has been notified to me, under the hand of the Clerk to the Board of Wardens for the Wellington Highway District, that the said Board did, on the third day of September, 1873, pass the following resolution, viz.: "That the Superintendent be requested to bring into operation the 12th clause of 'The Highways Act, 1871, Amendment Act, 1873,' in the Wellington Highway District."

Now, therefore I, William Fitzherbert, Superintendent, do hereby proclaim and appoint that Clause 12 of "The Highways Act, 1871, Amendment Act, 1873," above recited, shall be, and be deemed to be in force within the boundaries of the said Wellington Highway District on and after Monday, the thirteenth day of October, 1873.
