*Proclamation.*

By His Honor William Fitzherbert Esquire, C. M. G., Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by the Land Regulations now in force in the Province of Wellington it is declared that all reserves for the sites of Townships, or suburban lands for the sites of Agricultural and Small Farm Settlements, or for any other purpose of public advantage, safety, convenience, health, or enjoyment, shall be determined by the Superintendent, who shall notify the same by Proclamation wherein the object shall be specified for which any reserve shall be made.

And whereas it would be of public advantage if part of a certain section of land in the Township of Sandon in the Manawatu District, as per Schedule hereto, was set apart for a Public Park, now therefore I, William Fitzherbert, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in virtue of the power and authority vested in me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that part of Section No. 152, in the Township of Sandon, in the Manawatu District, containing forty acres, more or less, is hereby reserved and set apart by me for a Public Park.
