VICTORIA by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, to the Bank of Australasia, and to George Thomas, of Wellington, in the Province of Wellington, in the Wellington District of the Colony of New Zealand, Auctioneer, and to James Prendergast, of Wellington, aforesaid Attorney General of the said Colony, Greeting:—
