Proclamation.

By His Honor William Fitzherbert,
Esquire, C.M.G., Superintendent
of the Province of Wellington,
in the Colony of New Zealand.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Provincial Council of the said Province of Wellington, it is enacted that the Superintendent of the said Province may from time to time, by Proclamation, declare any pounds to be or cease to be public pounds within the meaning of the said Act, and may in like manner appoint, suspend, remove, and re-appoint keepers of such pounds. Now therefore, I, William Fitzherbert, Superintendent of the said Province, do hereby proclaim and declare the pound erected on Section No. Eight Hundred and Fifty-six (856), Township of Palmerston, in the Province of Wellington aforesaid, to be a public pound within the meaning of the said Act, and that James Donnelly be the keeper thereof.
