Proclamation.

By His Honor William Fitzherbert, Esquire, C.M.G., Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, in the Colony of New Zealand.

UNDER the provisions of the seventh clause of "The Highway Act, 1874," I, William Fitzherbert, Superintendent of the Province of Wellington, do hereby alter the boundaries of the Masterton Highway District and the boundaries of the Featherston Highway District, and direct that on and after Monday, the twenty-fifth day of October instant, the portion of land described in the Schedule hereto, and colored red on the plan hereto attached, shall cease to form a portion of Ward No. 5 (five) of the Masterton Highway District, and shall form part of and be added to Ward No. 1 (one) of the Featherston Highway District.

SCHEDULE.

All that parcel of land, estimated to contain about twenty thousand (20,000) acres, bounded towards the North by the Pohatariki stream, and by lines so as to include sections Nos. fifty-six (56), fifty-eight (58), sixty (60), sixty-one (61), thirty-eight (38), and forty (40), Ahiaruhi Block; towards the East by the Wangaehu River; towards the South by the Wangaehu and Huangarua Rivers; and towards the West by the Ruamahanga River.
