I, HERBERT SAMUEL WARDELL, Sheriff of the District of Wairarapa, do hereby give notice that by virtue of a Writ of *feri facias*, issued out of the above Honorable Court, and to me directed, I have caused my bailiff to enter upon all that piece or parcel of land, containing by admeasurement (172 acres 1 rood and 39 perches) one hundred and seventy-two acres one rood and thirty-nine perches, more or less, being part of the sections numbered (191) one hundred and ninety-one (202) two hundred and two and the whole of the section numbered (300) three hundred, on the plan of the Taratahi Plain block, in the Wairarapa district, bounded on the north-west by other part of the said sections, numbered (191 and 202) one hundred and ninety-one and two hundred and two, (5640) five thousand six hundred and forty links; on the north-east by a
