 Highway District.*

THE following Construction order has been received from the Chairman of the "Wangaeahu Highway Board."—

"The Wangaeahu Highway Board having considered the Plans, Sections and other documents deposited in respect of the proposed Makirikiri and Denlair lines of road, in the Wangaeahu Highway District, and having considered the various objections made by the owners, lessees, and occupiers of the intersected lands, to the lines as selected and laid off for the said proposed lines by the Board's Engineer the Board hereby order the said lines to be constructed according to the lines so selected and laid off."
