Johnsonville Local Board Bye-Laws.

IN pursuance of the 73rd section of "The Local Boards Act, 1873," the Commissioners of the Local District of Johnsonville order the following:—

"All fences of bush wood, furze, or other like material, within the township and suburban sections thereof, shall be kept thoroughly trimmed to a height of

not exceeding five feet. And every owner of, or occupier of any premises, who, after fourteen days' notice, shall neglect to trim or caused to be trimmed any such fence, shall forfeit, on conviction, any sum not exceeding Five pounds, and in every such case a sum not exceeding Forty shillings for every day after any such conviction, during which such fence shall remain untrimmed."
