YOUR Excellency,—We, the undersigned Memorialists, holders of Miners Rights, and occupying Waste Lands of the Crown for mining purposes, within the boundaries described in the schedule attached, humbly solicit that your Excellency will cause the district described to be proclaimed a Mining Drainage District under "The Gold Mining Claims Drainage Act, 1868." And we are further anxious that the necessary steps to initiate the proper working of the Act should be taken with the least possible delay. And your memorialists as in duty bound will ever pray, &c.
