PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by the 29th Section of "The Gold Fields Act, 1866," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, to demise for mining purposes, to any person, for any term not exceeding fifteen years from the making of the lease, any auriferous Crown Lands not exceeding ten acres in the whole of alluvial ground, or an area of 400 yards by 200 yards on a quartz reef and to grant sites for machinery and any necessary easements for the purposes aforesaid, subject, nevertheless, to the conditions or provisions in the said section contained:

And whereas, by the one hundred and ninth Section of the said Act, it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council under his hand and the Public Seal of the Colony, from time to time to delegate to such person as the Governor may think fit all or any of the powers vested in the Governor by the said Act, except the powers conferred by Sections twenty-two, forty, forty-eight, sixty, ninety-six, and one hundred and seven thereof, subject or not to any limitations or restrictions as he may think fit:

And whereas His Excellency Sir George Ferguson Bowen, the Governor of New Zealand, did, on the third day of February, 1869, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the Colony, delegate unto me Conrad Hoos, Chairman of the County Council of the County of Westland, all the powers vested in him by the twenty-ninth section of "The Gold Fields Act, 1866."

Now therefore, I, Conrad Hoos, Chairman of the County Council of the County of Westland, in exercise of the powers vested in me in that behalf, do hereby give notice that on the 16th day of June, 1870, I intend to demise to the persons named in the Schedule hereto annexed, certain auriferous Crown lands, containing quartz lodes or veins, for the term specified in the said Schedule.

REGULATION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HOKITIKA MADE UNDER SCHEDULE THIRTEEN IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY-TWO OF THE "MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT, 1867."

WHEREAS by a certain Regulation made by the Council of the Borough of Hokitika on the twelfth day of March, 1869, under the ninth subdivision of the first part of Schedule thirteen, and published in the *County of Westland Gazette* of April the 15th, 1869, No. 8, page 48, and which said Regulation is intitled as follows, that is to say—

OBSTRUCTION, ETC., TO STREETS, ETC., BY CATTLE, ETC.

And whereas it is desirable that the said Regulation should be repealed and other provisions made in lieu thereof, the Council of the Borough of Hokitika do therefore ordain as follows:—

1. That the said Regulation shall be, and the same is hereby repealed.

2. That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to drive into or through the Borough of Hokitika, or any part thereof, any Cattle intended for sale, slaughter, or shipment, or travelling from one part of New Zealand to any other place, unless it be between the hours of five o'clock at night and nine o'clock in the morning during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and between the hours of seven o'clock at night and eight o'clock in the morning during the months of October, November, December, January, February, March.

Passed by the Council of the Borough of Hokitika this sixth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

BYE LAW No. 11.

At a Meeting of the Mining Drainage Board of the District of Jones' Flat, begun and holden at Ross, in the said District, on the 31st of May, 1870, it is enacted as follows:—

That is to say—

Whereas the Mining Drainage Board of the District of Jones' Flat have passed a Bye-law for the purpose of levying a rate of twopence (2d) upon all rateable areas within the Drainage Area, No. 1, at Ross, for the purpose of defraying the cost of constructing and the formation of certain Drainage Tunnels, and other protective works within the said Drainage Area, No. 1, as aforesaid :

Be it therefore ordered and directed by the said Mining Drainage Board of the District of Jones' Flat, that an equal rate of twopence (2d.) is due and made payable to the Clerk of the said Mining Drainage Board, at his office, on Friday, the 17th day of June next, 1870, and which rate shall continue to be payable on every Friday in each week until notice to the contrary be given by the said Jones' Flat Mining Drainage Board.

The undersigned members of the said Mining Drainage Board concurred in making the forgoing Bye-law No. 11.
