ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this fourteenth day of May, 1873.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL.

**W**HEREAS, by "The Westland Waste Lands Act, 1870," it is among other things enacted that reserves heretofore or hereafter to be made of waste lands shall be managed and administered by the Governor in Council: And it is also enacted that the specified purposes for which any reserves shall be held may be changed, and any such reserves may be leased, mortgaged or sold, either in whole or in part by the Governor in Council, as therein mentioned: And whereas the several parcels of land described in the Schedule hereto were, on the dates and in the manner therein mentioned, declared to be reserves for the several purposes therein set forth, and such reserves are now subject to the provisions of the said Act: And whereas it is expedient that such reserves should be sold, and that the proceeds of such sale should form part of the Land Fund of the County:

Now, therefore, His Excellency Sir George Alfred Arney, the Officer Administering the Government of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority vested in him by the hereinbefore in part recited Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Colony, doth hereby order that the several parcels of land so reserved as aforesaid, and as the same are described in the Schedule hereto, shall be sold, and that the time, place, and conditions of such sale shall be fixed by the Waste Lands Board of the County of Westland, and shall be published in *The County of Westland Gazette* at least two calendar months before such sale shall take place; and it is declared that the proceeds of such sale shall form part of and be paid into the Public Account to the credit of and to form part of the Land Fund of the County.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House, at Wellington, this fourteenth day of May, 1873.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by "The Westland Waste Lands Act, 1870," it is among other things provided that the management of reserves for public gardens or recreation grounds may be vested, by Order of Council, in any Corporation, Commissioner, or other person or persons having corporate succession, under such restrictions and limitations as the Governor in Council shall think sufficient to secure the full maintenance of the purposes for which such reserve may have been made: And whereas the several parcels of land described in the Schedule hereto have been reserved and set apart for the purposes therein mentioned, and such reserves are now subject to the provisions of the said Act: And whereas it is expedient that the management of the said reserves should be vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Greymouth (hereinafter called the "Corporation"), in the manner hereinafter set forth:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise and pursuance of all power and authority in this behalf in him vested, doth hereby order and direct that the management of the several reserves mentioned in the said Schedule shall, from and after the date hereof, be vested in the Corporation, under and subject to the conditions and restrictions hereinafter set forth, that is to say:—

1. The Corporation shall have full powers of management and control of such reserves, and for that purpose may from time to time prescribe general regulations, but no such regulations shall have any force or effect until the same shall have received the assent of the Governor.

2. The Corporation shall not have any power to lease or otherwise dispose of any such reserve to any person or body corporate, or otherwise howsoever; but, upon the coming into operation of this Order in Council, they may take possession of any such reserve, and may fence and lay out the same in such manner as they may think fit, in order effectually to carry out the purposes for which the same has been reserved.

3. As to the reserves mentioned in the Second Part of the said Schedule, before any lease or disposition thereof shall be made to any person or body corporate, the consent of the Governor shall be obtained prior to the execution of the lease, and such consent if given, shall be endorsed on the intended lease; but, subject to this

**W**HEREAS by "The Westland Waste Lands Act, 1870," it is among other things enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time, by Order in Council, direct that reserves under the said Act shall vest in and be held by any Corporation, Commissioners, or other person or persons having corporate succession, to be named in the Order, in trust for the like or other public purposes to be specified and declared in such Order, in such manner, and with such powers of leasing for any term not exceeding twenty-one years from the date of the

lease, and of management of such reserves, and of disposing of the rents, issues, profits, and proceeds thereof, and other powers, provisions, and provisoes as shall be expressed and declared in such Order: And whereas the several parcels of land described in the Schedule hereto have been reserved and set apart for the purposes therein mentioned, and such reserves are now subject to the provisions of the said Act: And whereas it is expedient that the said reserves should be vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Hokitika (hereinafter called the "Corporation"), in the manner hereinafter mentioned:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise and pursuance of all power and authority in this behalf in him vested, doth hereby order and direct that from and after the date hereof the reserves particularly mentioned and described in the Schedule hereto shall vest in and be held by the Corporation in trust for the public service of the said Borough, with power to dispose of and manage such reserves under and subject to the following conditions, that is to say:—

1. The said reserves shall be vested in the Corporation for the several purposes mentioned in the Schedule, and in cases where the purpose for which such reserve was made shall be specified, the Corporation shall have no power to alter the same, but such reserve shall be held in trust for the particular purpose specified.

2. As to the reserves mentioned in the First Part of the said Schedule, the Corporation shall have power to lease the same, or any of them, to any person or persons, or to any body corporate, for any term not exceeding twenty-one years from the date of such lease, reserving such rent or rents as the Corporation may think fit; and every such lease shall contain all usual and proper covenants on the part of the lessee or lessees, and shall contain a condition or right of re-entry for breach of any of the provisions of such lease.

3. As to the reserves mentioned in the Second Part of the said Schedule, before any lease or disposition thereof shall be made to any person or body corporate, the consent of the Governor shall be obtained prior to the execution of the lease, and such consent, if given, shall be indorsed on the intended lease; but, subject to this condition, the Corporation shall have the like right of leasing any reserve mentioned in the Second Part of the said Schedule as is hereinbefore given with respect to the reserves mentioned in the First Part of the said Schedule, and the Governor may, if he think fit, refuse to assent to any such lease.

4. It shall be lawful for the Governor to require that any such lease as last aforesaid shall contain such additional covenants or conditions on the lessee's part as he may think fit and adapted to secure the effectual management of any such reserves.

5. The rents, issues, and profits to be received or derived from the leasing of any of the reserves mentioned in the said Schedule shall be vested in the Corporation, and by them received and appropriated to the Borough Fund, and may be applied thereout in such manner as the ordinary revenue of the Corporation may be applied.

**£10,000 OFFERED AS REWARDS TO DISCOVERERS OF NEW GOLD FIELDS.**

**T**HE following terms and conditions on which rewards will be paid for the discovery of new gold fields are issued in pursuance of the following resolution of the House of Representatives, passed on the 26th September, 1872:—

*Resolved*, "That in the opinion of this House, rewards, to the extent of £5000 in each island, should be offered for the discovery of new gold fields, on specific terms and conditions to be notified by the Government, and the House pledges itself to make good the same."

**CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH REWARDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR THE DISCOVERY OF NEW GOLD FIELDS FROM THE DATE HEREOF TILL THE 31ST DECEMBER, 1874.**

I. That person will be deemed the discoverer who shall first find gold and notify the same, in writing, either to the Superintendent of the Province, or to the Chairman of the County of Westland, or the nearest Warden or Resident Magistrate. In such notification the discoverer shall state as nearly as practicable the exact locality and the distance from the nearest gold workings or nearest town.

II. If two or more persons simultaneously discover gold in the same locality or in places immediately adjacent, and they each severally comply with the conditions above mentioned, the sum proper to be awarded will be divided amongst the several persons who have discovered the gold field in such manner as shall be determined after due investigation by the Secretary for Crown Lands or his appointee.

III. Rewards will only be given for discoveries made public subsequently to the publication of this notice.

*Conditions applicable to North Island.*

(a.) The newly discovered gold field must

be distant at least thirty miles from the nearest gold workings.

(b.) A reward of £5000 will be given to the first newly-discovered gold field that yields 25,000 ounces between the date hereof and the 31st December, 1874. Should the yield not amount to 25,000 ounces, the reward will be reduced according to the following graduated scale:—

£4000	if the field yield	20,000 ounces	
		before 31st December,	1874.
£3000	" "	15,000	" "
£2000	" "	10,000	" "
£1000	" "	5000	" "

(c.) No prospecting to be allowed on Native land without the consent of the Native owners previously obtained and the approval of the Native Minister.

(d.) Prospectors going on Native land without consent of the owners are liable to the penalties imposed by the Acts relating to Gold Fields, and will forfeit all claim to the reward.

(e.) Native owners will be entitled to rewards, provided that, if the discovery be made on their own land, they enter into arrangement with the Government for throwing such land open for mining purposes to the public.

*Conditions applicable to Middle Island.*

(a.) The newly discovered gold field must be distant at least 10 miles from the nearest gold workings.

(b.) No reward shall exceed £2000.

(c.) Rewards, not exceeding in the whole £5000, will be given in accordance with the following scale:—

IV. The words "nearest gold workings" shall mean gold workings recognized as such, and on which miners are actually employed in searching for gold.
